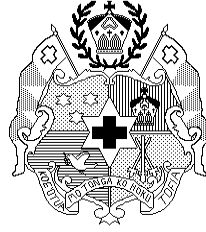

- 1 ‘Oku loto‘a e ‘Ofisi ‘o e ‘Ateni Seniale ke fakaha ke mea’i ‘e he Hou’eiki mo ‘ilo ki ai ‘a e kakai ‘o e Fonua, ‘e fakahoko ‘a e Uike Lao 2018 mei he ‘aho Sapate 4 Novema ki he ‘aho Falaite 9 Novema 2018.
- 2 Ko e kaveinga ki he Uike Lao 2018 ko e Lao mo e Ngaluope (Law and Cyberspace).
- 3 Ko e taumu‘a ‘o e Uike Lao 2018 ke fakaha ki he kakai ‘o e fonua ‘a e lao ‘oku ngaue’aki ki hono ngaue’aki ‘o e ngaluope, pea pehe ki he ngaahi lelei mo e ngaahi pole lolotonga ‘i hono ngaue’aki ‘o e ngaluope mei he ngaahi komipiuta mo e ngaahi komipiuta to’oto’o, pea ko e faka’amu ko kinautolu ‘oku nau ngaue’aki ‘a e ngaluope, tautautefito ki he fanau mo e to’utupu, tenau fakatokanga’i ange ‘a e ngaahi fakatu’utamaki ‘i he ngaluope, pea kenau fakahaofi kinautolu mei he ngaahi fakatu’utamaki ko’eni ‘aki ‘enau ngaue fakapotopoto pe ‘a kinautolu pe ko ha tokanga’i makehe kinautolu ‘e he kau tauhi fanau.
- 4 Ko e ta’u hono hongofulu-ma taha (11) eni ‘a hono fakahoko ‘e he ‘Ofisi ‘o e ‘Ateni Seniale ‘a e Uike Lao.

- 5 'Oku fakahoko 'a e Uike Lao 'i he ta'u kotoa pe ke faka-manatu hono foaki 'o e Konisitutone 'e he 'Ene 'Afio kuo Ungafonua, Kingi Siaosi Tupou I 'i he 'aho 4 Novema 1875.
- 6 'I he 'aho Sapate 4 Novema 2018, ko e ta'u ia 'e 143 mei hono foaki 'o e Konisitutone, ko e lao ma'olunga taha ia, pea ko e makatu'unga ia 'o e ngaahi lao mo e ngaahi mafai kotoa pe 'i he Fonua.
- 7 Ko ia ai, 'e kamata'aki 'a eUike Lao 'a e ouau lotu fakamanatu 'i he 'aho Sapate 4 Novema 2018 'i he Falelotu Senituli 'o e Siasi Uesiliana Tau'ataina 'o Tonga 'i Nuku'alofa, pea 'e tataki ia 'e he tangata'eiki Palesiteni 'o e Siasi Uesiliana Tau'ataina 'o Tonga, Dr Faifekau 'Ahio.
- 8 Lolotonga 'a e Uike Lao 2018, 'e fakamanatu foki 'e he 'Ofisi 'o e 'Ateni Seniale 'a e hokosia 'a e ta'u 'e 30 'a hono fokotu'u 'o e lakanga 'Ateni Seniale pea mo e Fakahinohino Lao Seniale 'e He'ene 'Afio 'a e Tama Tu'i kuo Ungafonua, Tama ko Kingi Tauha'afau Tupou IV, 'a ia ko 'Ene 'Afio ko e fuofua Tonga ia na'a ne lava'i kakato 'a e maa'imoa ako mata'itohi lao.
- 9 Ko e 'Ateni Seniale ko e 'Ofisa Lao 'Uluaki ia 'o e Kalauni, pea ko e Fakahinohino Lao Seniale ko e 'Ofisa Lao Ua ia 'o e Kalauni.
- 10 Ko e fokotu'u 'a e ongo lakanga ni 'i he 1988 ko e kamata ia ke fakahoko mo tataki 'e he kau Tonga kuo nau lava'i lelei 'a e ako mata'itohi lao 'a e kotoa 'a e ngaahi ngaue faka-lao ma'ae Pule'anga pea mo e kakai 'o e Fonua.
- 11 Ko e fuofua 'Ateni Seniale ko Tevita Poasi Tupou, 'a ia na'e fakanofu 'e He'ene 'Afio kuo Ungafonua, Tama Tu'i ko Kingi Siaosi Tupou V ko 'Eiki Tupou 'o Kolofu'ou, ko e 'Eiki Law 'a 'Ene 'Afio pea Memipa 'o e Fakataha Tokoni. Ko e fuofua Fakahinohino Lao Seniale ko 'Aisea Havea Taumoepeau, 'a ia na'e to e hoko ko e 'Ateni Seniale, pea ko ia 'oku 'Omipatime'i 'i he lolotonga ni.

- 12 Kimu'a pea fokotu'u 'a e ongo lakanga ni, ko e ngaahi ngaue faka-lao 'a e Pule'anga na'e fakahoko ia 'e he Solisitoa 'a e Kalauni (Crown Solicitor), pea na'e fakahoko fatongia ia 'i he malumalu 'o e 'Ofisi 'o e Palemia. Ko e lakanga koia na'e ngaue ai 'a e kau muli mei Pilitania pea mo 'Aositelelia, pea toki fakanofu 'a Taniela Hoko'ila Tufui, kuo ne pekia, ko e fuofua Tonga ke Solisitoa 'a e Kalauni, pea toki hoko ko e Sekelitali Pule mo e Sekelitali ki he Kapineti, pea toki fakanofu 'e He'ene 'Afio kuo Ungafonua Tama Tu'i ko Kingi Siaosi Tupou V ke hoko ko 'Eiki Tufui 'o Talaheu, ko e 'Eiki Lao 'a 'Ene 'Afio mo e Memipa 'o e Fakataha Tokoni.
- 13 'E fakahoko 'a e Uike Lao 'i he ngaahi polokalama felafoaki 'e fakahoko atu mei he Letio FM 90 'a e Letio Tonga 'i he taimi 5 efiafi ki he 6.30 efiafi mei he 'aho Monite 5 Novema ki he Falaite 9 Novema.
- 14 'I he 'aho Tusite 6 Novema 2018 é fakahoko 'a e polokalama Fakafe'iloaki (Open Day) 'e fakaava 'e he 'Eiki Minisita ki he Fakamatala mo e Fetu'utaki, Poasi Tei, 'i he Digicel Square 'i Nuku'alofa, ma'ae fanau ako lautohi si'i 'e ni'ihii mei he ngaahi vahenga Hahake mo Hihifo 'o Tongatapu. 'E fakahoko ki he fanau ako 'a e ngaahi fakamatala mei he 'Ofisi 'o e 'Ateni Seniale, Kau Polisi Tonga, Kautaha Fetu'utaki 'o Tonga, Kautaha Digicel, CERT Tonga pea mo e ngaahi kupu fekau'aki kehe 'oku nau poupuu ki hono ngaue'aki malu 'o e ngaluope. 'E fakahoko foki pea mo e ngaahi polokalama kehe mo e ngaahi fe'auhi ma'ae fanau ako.
- 15 Ko e ngaahi polokalama kotoa pe 'e fakamafola atu ia 'i he Letio Tonga telia 'a kinautolu tenau me'a mai mei he ngaahi 'otu motu pehe kia tekinautolu tenau me'a mai mei muli 'i he ngaluope.
- 16 'Oku fakaafe'i atu 'e he 'Ofisi 'o e 'Ateni Seniale 'a Hou'eiki mo e Kakai 'o e Fonua kenau kau mai 'i hono fakamanatu 'a e pule mo e ngaue 'a e lao 'i Tonga ni, pea mo e ngaue'aki 'a e lao ke tokoni ki hono malu'i 'a kinautolu 'oku nau ngaue'aki 'a e ngaluope, pea ke fakalotolahi'i 'a hono ngaue'aki 'a e ngaluope ke fakalakalaka 'a e tu'unga mo'ui 'a e kakai 'o e Fonua.

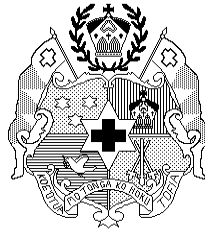

LAW WEEK 2018: LAW AND CYBERSPACE AND 30th ANNIVERSARY OF ESTABLISHMENT OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL AND SOLICITOR GENERAL POSTS

1 November 2018

- 1 The Attorney General's Office wishes to inform the public that it will deliver Law Week 2018 from Sunday 4 November to Friday 9 November 2018.
- 2 The theme for Law Week 2018 will be the Law and Cyberspace.
- 3 The objective of Law Week 2018 is to inform the public of the law that is applicable to the use of cyberspace, and the current benefits and challenges in the use of cyberspace through computers and mobile devices, and hopefully the users of cyberspace, especially the children and youth, become more aware of the risks in cyberspace, and to protect themselves from these risks either by their own reasonable actions or active supervision by their guardians.
- 4 This will be the eleventh year that the Attorney General's Office has delivered Law Week.
- 5 Law Week is delivered annually as part of the celebrations of the granting of the Constitution by the late King George Tupou I on 4 November 1875.

- 6 Sunday 4 November 2018 will be the 143rd anniversary of the granting of the Constitution, which is the supreme law, and the source of all law and authority in the Kingdom.
- 7 Accordingly, Law Week will start off with a commemorative church service on Sunday 4 November 2018 at the Centenary Church of the Free Wesleyan Church of Tonga in Nuku'alofa, which will be led by Dr the Reverend 'Ahio, President of the Free Wesleyan Church of Tonga.
- 8 During Law Week 2018, the Attorney General's Office will also be celebrating the 30th anniversary of the establishment of the posts of the Attorney General and the Solicitor General by His Majesty the Late King Taufa'ahau Tupou IV, who was the first ever Tongan law graduate.
- 9 The Attorney General is the First Law Officer of the Crown, and the Solicitor General is the Second Law Officer of the Crown.
- 10 The establishment of these posts in 1988 marked the beginning of Tongan law graduates delivering and directing all legal services for Government and the people of the Kingdom.
- 11 The first Attorney General was the Hon Tevita Poasi Tupou, who was later appointed by His Majesty the Late King George Tupou V as Lord Tupou of Kolofo'ou, and Law Lord of His Majesty and Member of the Privy Council. The first Solicitor General was 'Aisea Havea Taumoepeau, who also served as Attorney General, and is now the Ombudsman.
- 12 Before these posts were established, the Government legal services were provided by a Crown Solicitor, who worked under the Prime Minister's Office. This post was usually occupied by expatriates from the United Kingdom and Australia, until the late Taniela Hoko'ila Tufui was appointed as the first Tongan Crown Solicitor, and who later became Chief Secretary and Secretary to Cabinet, and who was later appointed by His Majesty the Late King George Tupou V as Lord Tufui of Talaheu, and Law Lord of His Majesty and Member of the Privy Council.

- 13 Law Week will involve daily radio talkback shows from Radio FM 90 of Radioa Tonga at 5pm to 6.30pm from Monday 5 November to Friday 9 November.
- 14 On Tuesday 6 November 2018, an Open Day will be opened by Hon Poasi Tei, Minister for Information and Communications, to be held at the Digicel Square in Nuku'alofa for some Government Primary School students from the Eastern and Western Districts of Tongatapu. The students will be presented with information from the Attorney General's Office, Tonga Police, Tonga Communications Corporation, Digicel, CERT Tonga and other stakeholders who support the safe use of cyberspace. This will also include special activities and competitions for the students.
- 15 All programmes will be broadcast on Radio Tonga for the benefit of those who would be listening from the outer islands and also from overseas via the internet.
- 16 Members of the public are invited by the Attorney General's Office to contribute in this celebration of the rule of law in Tonga, and the use of the law to help protect users of cyberspace, and also to encourage the use of cyberspace to advance standards of living of people in the Kingdom.
